The General Body of the Dental Council of India at its meeting held on 11th & 12th Sept. 1993 at New Delhi considered the above said Inspection Report and letters (i) No.RDC/36/Insp./93 dated 14.8.93 and (ii) No.RDC/36/INSP/93 dated 25.8.93 from the Principal, Rajas Dental College, Vadakangulam thereby furnishing the fresh list of Teaching Staff indicating their names, designation, qualification & teaching experience and their joining Reports as Compliance Report on the said Inspection Report to ascertain the physical facilities available at Rajas Dental College, Vadakangulam for the recognition of the BDS degree of Madurai Kamaraj University in respect of the BDS students of the said College alongwith the recommendations of the Executive Committee (Sept., 1993)

The Council after some discussion decided as under:-

"That the Inspection Report is noted.

The Council noted the minor deficiency in the Compliance Reports in respect of Readers but the excess of Professor & tutors can be considered for this deficiency.

The Compliance Report be accepted and the BDS degree of the Madurai Kamaraj University in respect of the BDS students of the Rajas Dental College, Vadankangulam (Tamil Nadu) be recognised.

The College authorities are advised to correct the designation of the Teaching Staff according to the DCI norms."

The above decision of the Council is communicated to you for your information and necessary action in the matter.

It may also be requested to kindly approach the Madurai Kamaraj University to write direct to the Secretary to the Govt. of India, Ministry of Health & F.W., New Delhi with a request to notify the same in their official Gazette as required under section 10(2) of the Dentists Act 1948 for the recognition of the BDS degree of the Madurai Kamaraj University in respect of the BDS students of the Rajas Dental College, Vadakangulam (T.N.)
